2003 SUMMER D.A.R.E. CAMP

The Fresno County Sheriff's Department, in conjunction with YMCA, is sponsoring the tenth annual D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) Camp.

The first of three, five-day camps will start on Monday, June 9, 2003. The first D.A.R.E. Camp will be held at YMCA facilities at Tulequoia at Lake Sequoia. Lake Sequoia is located on Highway 180, .5 miles east of Highway 245. The purpose of Camp D.A.R.E. is to provide positive reinforcement and leadership training to students who have successfully completed the Fresno County Sheriff's Department Drug Abuse Resistance Education curriculum.

The students will have the opportunity to spend the week with sworn and civilian employees of the Fresno County Sheriff's Department. Assisting the Sheriff's Department employees will be Fresno County Sheriff's Department Explorer Scouts.

On Thursday June 12, 2003 a special Career Day will be held where students will be treated to demonstrations and displays by the Fresno County Sheriff's Department Canine, SWAT, Boating Enforcement, Dive and Search and Rescue Units, and Eagle One Helicopter.
