## Victim dies of injuries sustained during disturbance

On March 14, 2004, victim David Yount - 34 yrs - died as a result of injuries sustained during an altercation that occurred in the 11000 block of East California, near Sanger, back on March 9<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 8pm. During that incident, the victim is believed to have been run down by the suspect who then fled the scene. The victim had sustained severe head injuries.

The suspect, who is still outstanding, is Salvador Vasquez. He is described as a Hispanic Male Adult, approximately 27 years old, light complexion and possibly clean shaven. Vasquez may also be using the name Eduardo Guevara, Salvador Huerta, or the street name "Chava". This subject 'may' be injured. A murder warrant has been issued for his arrest; his bail is set at one million dollars.

The vehicle involved in the incident (which is still outstanding) is a 1987 Nissan Pathfinder SUV, Red in color, with possible Arizona license plate 626JGH. The vehicle should be missing the right headlight assembly and passenger side-view mirror. There may be moderate to extensive front-end damage, and the vehicle was also last seen with a "For Sale" sign in the back window.

Vasquez may also be driving a mid 1980's model Blue ford Taurus, also with Arizona License plates.
