Fresno County Sheriff's Department Seeks Help in Identity of Deceased Person

The Fresno County Sheriff's Department is asking for the public's help in identifying a female found deceased in the area of Jefferson Ave. and Tuolumne Ave., in western Fresno County.

The female was found on April 12th, 2005, at about 4:30 p.m. The coroner's office completed an autopsy and has determined that she appears to have been the victim of a homicide.

She is described as being an African-American adult, possibly between the ages of 18 and 40 years old. She was found wearing a light-colored sweater, gray and white vest jacket, blue jeans and red Nike tennis shoes. On her upper right leg, the female also had a tattoo with the name "Glenn" in cursive writing and underlined with a red rose (see attached photo).
