**SEARCH WARRANT NETS METHAMPHETAMINE
AND ARREST**

Sheriff Richard Pierce announced today that on Thursday, December 1, 2005 the Fresno County Sheriff's Department South West Street Narcotics Enforcement Team (S/W Street NET) served a Search Warrant in the 400 block of West Palm in the City in Reedley.

Narcotics Detectives had received allegations that drugs were being sold from a residence on this street. This location is within close proximity to Reedley High School and T. L. Reed Elementary School. With the allegation information detectives initiated an investigation and were able to secure a search warrant for the residence. During the service of the search warrant detectives seized Methamphetamine and drug sales paraphernalia. Arrested for possession for sales of Methamphetamine and possession of drugs for sale within proximity of a school was Lynn Marie Everett, 23. Arrested for being under the influence of Methamphetamine was Joshawa Phil Garnier, 24.

The South West Street Narcotics Enforcement Team is comprised of detectives from the Sheriff's Department and the Sanger, Reedley and Kerman Police Departments.
