## **Fresno County Sheriff's Department Investigates Double Stabbing**

Today the Fresno County Sheriff's Department received a 9-1-1 call regarding two victims who were stabbed at Highway 198 and Interstate 5, in western Fresno County. Patrol Deputies determined that the two victims were stabbed during a domestic disturbance. One victim suffered life-threatening stab wounds and was flown to UMC via helicopter. The second victim suffered stab wounds but was not injured as seriously as the other victim. Neither victim's name is being released at this time.

Patrol deputies developed information on the whereabouts of the suspect. Deputies responded to the suspect's residence in the Coalinga area, and took him into custody without incident. A knife believed to have been used in the attack was recovered near the suspect's residence. The suspect has not been positively identified. He was booked into the Fresno County Jail under the name Jose Manuel Oseguera (34 years-old). Detectives are continuing to investigate and anticipate filing attempted homicide charges on the suspect.
