**MEDIA ADVISORY: Arrest of Burglary Suspects**

On February 13, 2007, Fresno County Sheriff's Deputies arrested three suspected burglars at a residence located in the 2100 block of S. Willow Ave in Fresno.

At approximately 1115 hrs, deputies were dispatched to the residence regarding a possible burglary in progress. Upon their arrival, deputies observed three male subjects running from the property. One of the subjects, 21 year old Pedro Alaniz, was immediately detained by arriving deputies. The two other subjects, 36 year old Juan Gallegos and 29 year old Guillermo Alvarez, were detained a short time later with the assistance of the Sheriff's K-9, California Highway Patrol helicopter, and Fresno Police Officers.

Further investigation revealed that a burglary had been committed at the residence.

Alaniz was found to be on parole and was arrested for burglary, resisting a police officer and parole violations. Gallegos was arrested for burglary and several outstanding warrants. Alvarez was arrested for burglary.
