**MEDIA ADVISORY: Juveniles Arrested After Burglary Of School**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrest of two juveniles for burglarizing a building on the Central High School West campus at 2045 N. Dickenson Ave, in western Fresno County.

On 4-1-07 at approximately 1:00am, Sonitrol Alarm contacted the Sheriff's Department and reported that they were monitoring a silent burglar alarm at the high school. Responding Deputies located an open gate and confirmed that a burglary had occurred in one of the buildings. A search of the campus located the two juveniles who attempted to flee from deputies. Both juveniles, ages 14 & 16, were eventually taken into custody. A vehicle located at the scene was found to contain miscellaneous items including tools and stuffed animals that had been taken during the burglary.

Both juveniles were later transported to the Fresno County Juvenile Justice facility where they were booked on burglary charges.
