**MEDIA ADVISORY: Information Requested In “Hot Prowl” Burglary**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's assistance regarding a “Hot Prowl” burglary that occurred on April 4, 2007, near the city of Fowler.

On that date at approximately 2:15pm, patrol deputies were dispatched to the 4800 block of E Adams regarding a burglary in-progress call.

Investigation revealed that an 18 year old resident was home alone when she heard glass breaking, and then someone running through the house. When she went to investigate, she observed two Hispanic male subjects inside her residence. One of the suspects was in the process of unlocking the front door to exit with two cases of beer. The victim confronted the second suspect in a back bedroom and started yelling at him to get out of the house. The suspect then ran out of the front door and got into a truck that was parked in front of the residence. The victim observed as many as 4 more Hispanic male subjects in the truck, ranging in age from 12 to 40 years old.

The suspect's vehicle is described an unknown make, gold or tan colored, full sized four door pick up truck with a matching camper shell. (See attached photo)
