**MEDIA ADVISORY: “Hot Prowl” Burglary Suspect
Wanted**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's assistance in locating a wanted “Hot Prowl” burglary suspect.

On 3-31-07 at approximately 0830 hrs, patrol deputies responded to a residence located in the 1400 block of E Austin Way in Fresno regarding a burglary call. The suspect had apparently entered the victim's residence during the night while the victim was asleep. Over \$7000.00 in property had been taken.

Evidence recovered at the scene has positively identified 22 year old Fresno resident, Juan Manuel Garza as the person responsible for the burglary. Garza, who also goes by the name “Johnny Green”, is described as a black male, 5-7/approximately 210lbs, with short black hair.

In addition to the burglary, Garza is also wanted on an outstanding felony warrant for robbery.
