May 7-13 has been designated as National Peace Officers' Memorial Week.

A multi-agency observance is scheduled for Tuesday, May 1, 2007. The event will take place at 12:00pm, at the Fresno County Peace Officers' Memorial in Courthouse Park.

The ceremony will honor all California Peace Officers who have lost their lives in the service of their communities.

Officers' names and agencies will be read. Honor Guard from local law enforcement agencies will be participating in the ceremony.
