**MEDIA ADVISORY: Two Juveniles Shot During Disturbance**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's help in identifying the person, or persons responsible for a shooting that occurred on Sunday, April 29 at approximately 1:40am.

The investigation began when the Sheriff's Department started receiving numerous calls regarding a large party with shots fired in the area Belmont & McCall in east of Fresno.

Upon arrival, deputies located the possible shooting scene at a residence located in the 10100 block of E Belmont. Although there were no victims, information received from witnesses identified an Asian male as being responsible for the shooting.

Approximately 40 minutes after the original calls, officers with the California Highway Patrol located the two juveniles that had been shot.

The victims, a 16 year old female who had sustained a gunshot wound to the neck, and a 17 year old male with a grazing wound to the back, had been shot as the drove away from the party. The injuries to both victims were considered to be non-life threatening. Both were transported by ambulance to Community Regional Medical Center for treatment.
