MEDIA ADVISORY: Subject Arrested On Suspicion Of Attempted Wire Theft

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrest of 27 year old Jeffrey Wayne Feagin on attempted wire theft charges.

On April 27 at approximately 11:00pm, a security guard for Lehman's Manufacturing, located in the 4900 block of E Jensen, observed Feagin in the yard of the business hiding behind a trailer. As the security guard approached, Feagin climbed over the fence and attempted to flee. A short time later, Feagin again attempted to climb back over the fence into the yard. The guard was able to detain Feagin and call the Sheriff's Department.

When deputies arrived, they discovered an approximate 3 foot long pair of insulated wire cutters and an adjustable wrench, both located at the same spot inside the yard where Feagin had initially been observed trying to hide.

Deputies also discovered an approximately 50' section of insulated copper wire that had been completely cut through on one end, and partially cut through on the other end.

Feagin was taken into custody and later transported to the Fresno County Jail where he was booked on the charge.
