**MEDIA ADVISORY: Sanger Shooting**

On May 4, 2007 at approximately 7:30pm, Sanger Police officers responded to the 900 block of "I" St, regarding a 'shots fired' call. Upon their arrival, officers located a male subject who had been shot.

The victim was transported by ambulance to Community Regional Medical Center where his condition was listed as grave and critical.

Investigators from the Fresno County Sheriff's Homicide Unit were requested to handle the investigation.

The investigation revealed the suspect in the shooting to be a Hispanic male young adult with short or shaved hair, and a goatee. The suspect is to be considered armed and dangerous.

The suspect vehicle is described as a red colored, 2000 to 2003 Chevy S10, (or GMC Sonoma), extended cab pick up truck with chrome rims.

Homicide investigators were assisted by MAGEC officers however, at this time they do not consider the shooting to be gang related.

Additionally, a large religious event taking place at a park, one block away, was unrelated to the shooting incident.
