MEDIA ADVISORY: Stabbing Suspect Sought

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's help in locating the suspect in a stabbing that occurred on Friday, May 4 at approximately 5:30pm in the Mayfair area of Fresno.

The suspect, 54 year old Fresno resident Blake Edward Moore, is being sought on charges of assault with a deadly weapon.

Deputies had responded to Moore's residence located in the 3900 block of Kenmore Drive North regarding an assault with a deadly weapon call. Upon arrival, deputies learned that Moore had been involved in a disagreement with his younger brother. During the incident, Moore grabbed a steak knife and stabbed his brother once in the neck. The victim was able to get to a neighbor's residence where he called 911. Moore fled the area before deputies arrived on scene.

The victim was transported to Community Regional Medical Center where he was treated for a non-life threatening wound to the neck.

Moore is described as a white male, 5-8, approximately 145 lbs. He has short brown hair and a mustache. He was last seen wearing blue levis and a red shirt.

Moore also has an outstanding arrest warrant for narcotics violations.
