MEDIA ADVISORY: Suspects Arrested In Stolen Vehicle

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrests of 37 year old Amador Cisneros Sr. and 26 year old Juan Jose Tellez on charges of possession of stolen property.

On May 7 at approximately 1:00pm, Deputy Erich Garringer developed information that Tellez and Cisneros were driving around the area of Orange Cove in a stolen vehicle.

Moments later, Deputy Garringer observed the subjects and vehicle driving on Eighth St. near Park St. A check of the vehicle found it to be a 1989 Hyundai Excel, previously stolen out of Tulare County.

Upon seeing the deputy, Cisneros, who was driving, stopped the vehicle and both subjects fled. Deputy Garringer was able to chase down Cisneros and take him into custody.

Tellez was last seen running into an apartment complex in the area of Center St. and E St. With the assistance of other deputies, Tellez was located hiding behind a door in the complex. He was also taken into custody without further incident.

Further investigation revealed checks, identification, and a cell phone inside the vehicle that had been reported stolen during a vehicle burglary in Orosi, CA.

Cisneros and Tellez, both Orange Cove residents, were transported to the Fresno County jail where they were booked on multiple charges of possession of stolen property and resisting arrest.
