**MEDIA ADVISORY: Suspect In Vehicle Burglary Taken
Into Custody After Foot Pursuit**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrest of 23 year old Orange Cove resident, Gilbert Maximilliano Galaviz on vehicle burglary charges.

On April 26th at approximately 8:50am, patrol deputies responded to a residence located in the 700 block of Second St in Orange Cove regarding a vehicle burglary call. After breaking into the vehicle, the suspects stole the car stereo and fled.

Evidence located in the vehicle positively identified Galaviz as being responsible for the burglary.

On May 15th at approximately 11:05am, deputies spotted Galaviz walking in the area of Eighth & B streets. When Galaviz saw the deputies approach, he started running. He was ordered to stop but jumped over a fence into the back yard of a residence.

Assisting deputies were able to set up a perimeter while others chased after Galaviz. Galaviz was eventually caught hiding under a vehicle parked in a carport. He was taken into custody without further incident and transported to the Fresno County Jail where he was booked.

In addition to the open charges, Galaviz also had an outstanding arrest warrant for narcotics violations.
