**MEDIA ADVISORY: Subjects Wanted For Questioning In
2007 Homicide**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's help in locating several subjects that are wanted for questioning in the murder of Jose "Monkey" Guzman earlier this year.

Guzman was last seen on the evening of March 4, 2007 in the area of Cedar & Lane Avenues in the City of Fresno. His body was later found in his burned Chevy Tahoe in the area of Fruit & American Avenues in Fresno County.

Investigation has revealed that the following subjects may have information regarding Guzman's death.

Subject #1: Abundio Mendoza Gaytan, also known as "Alex Suarez" or "Huero". He is described as a Hispanic male in his mid 20s. He is approximately 5-8, with a thin build. He also has light brown hair. (Photo attached.)

Subject #2: Alondra Mendoza. She is described as a Hispanic female, 24 years old, 5-0 with a small build. She has black hair and brown eyes. (Photo attached.)

Subject #3: Yasmany Mendoza, also known as "Ricardo Lara Sanchez". He is described as a Hispanic male, approximately 25 years old. He is 5-11/170 lbs with brown hair and hazel eyes. (Photo attached.)

Subject #4: Felipe Villagomez, also known as "Gallo". He is described as a Hispanic male, approximately 25 years old. (Photo attached.)

Subject #5: Gonzalo Mendoza, also known as “Chalo” or “Augustine”. He is described as a Hispanic male, 19 years old. He is approximately 5-7 with a chunky build. (No photo available.)

Four of the subjects are known to be siblings and have family in the McFarland and Dinuba areas of Tulare County. Yasmany Mendoza also has contacts in the City of Wasco in Kern County. All of the subjects are originally from Michoacan, Mexico.

One or more of the subjects may be using a blue colored Honda Accord.
