**MEDIA ADVISORY: Fresno County Plaza Building Victim
Of Theft**

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's assistance in identifying the subjects responsible for the theft of several computers from the Fresno County Plaza building.

On May 17 at approximately 1:40pm, patrol deputies arrived at the Plaza building in regarding the burglary of vending machine. The suspect(s) had vandalized two change machines, and stolen the money from both. They had also stolen one vending machine and vandalized several other machines, removing items from all of them. The losses and damages of all of the machines is estimated to be approximately \$1,190.00.

Deputies were then contacted by Fresno County Security who advised that several computers had also been stolen from a storage area located on the 15th floor of the Plaza building.

The investigation revealed that seven computers belonging to the Fresno County Department of Child Support Services and some video equipment had been stolen. The loss was estimated to be over \$22,000.00.
