MEDIA ADVISORY: Suspects Arrested For Prior Shooting

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrest of two Fresno men in connection with a shooting incident that occurred last month. Arrested were 18 year old Feng Chia Xiong and 18 year old Mong Xiong.

The original shooting occurred on May 20th at a residence located in the 5900 block of E. Tam O Shanter Ave. in Fresno. During the incident, a traditional Hmong wedding was taking place when some of the guests became involved in a disturbance. During the disturbance, some of the subjects involved retrieved guns from their vehicles and shot rounds into the house. No one was injured by the gunfire.

Deputies learned that the shooting may have been gang related.

As a result of the ongoing investigation, early this morning, Homicide investigators served search warrants at four separate locations. Investigators were assisted by members of the Sheriff's SWAT Team and MAGEC. The search warrants were served at residences at the following locations:

2000 block of S. 8th St, Fresno
2000 block of S. 7th St, Fresno
6100 block of N. Orchard, Fresno
9100 block of E. Jensen Ave, Sanger

Evidence was recovered that connected both suspects to the shooting.

Feng Chia Xiong was arrested at the S. 8th St. address on charges of assault with a deadly weapon and shooting into an inhabited residence. Mong Xiong was arrested at the N. Orchard Ave. address on charges of possession of stolen property. Both were later transported to the Fresno County Jail where they were booked.
