MEDIA ADVISORY: Subject Sought In West Side Burglaries

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims is asking for the public's assistance in locating a subject responsible for at least two residential burglaries that recently occurred west of Fresno. Wanted is 47 year old David William Fraulob of Fresno.

The investigation began on June 21st when deputies responded to a burglary call at a residence located in the 4100 block of N. Floyd Ave. The suspect entered by removing slats at the rear of the residence. Numerous items of property were taken.

On June 24th, the Sheriff's Department received another report of a burglary that occurred at a residence located in the 9000 block of W. Shaw Ave. This time, the suspect entered the residence through a rear window and stole numerous items of property, including three handguns.

As a result of the investigation, property detectives served a search warrant at Fraulob's residence located in the 4300 block of N. Floyd Ave. During the service of the search warrant, stolen property from both burglaries was recovered. Evidence from both burglaries was also located in the residence.

Fraulob, a parolee, was not at his residence when the search warrant was served. He is being sought on charges of burglary and possession of stolen property.
