MEDIA ADVISORY: Two Arrested In Stolen Vehicle

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret today announced the arrests of two subjects on charges of stolen vehicle, possession of stolen property and resisting arrest. Arrested were 25 year old Moses Luis Aguilar from Auburn, CA, and 25 year old Tabitha Nicolette Tetrick from Lincoln, CA.

On July 1st at approximately 11:55pm, deputies observed a brown colored Ford Expedition tailgating another vehicle on Fwy 99 at Manning Ave. A check of the vehicle found it to be a reported stolen vehicle from Lincoln, California.

As the vehicle exited on Manning Ave, deputies lost sight of it for a short time. With the assistance of a Fowler Police unit, the vehicle was located in the parking lot of a convenience store located at 2702 Vineyard Place in Fowler.

Tetrick, who was standing beside the vehicle, was immediately detained by responding officers who advised that the driver had exited the vehicle and was last seen walking eastbound on Manning Ave.

As deputies arrived on scene, they spotted Aguilar walking on Manning Ave. near Golden State Blvd. When deputies attempted to stop Aguilar, he started running southbound on Golden state in the middle of the roadway. The suspect then ran into a parking lot with patrol cars directly behind him. Aguilar finally stopped, put up his hands, and lay down on the ground. He was taken into custody without further incident.

Further investigation revealed that the vehicle had been stolen from Lincoln, California on June 16th.

In addition to the open charges, it was learned that Aguilar was also a wanted parolee and he was booked on the outstanding arrest warrant.
