MEDIA ADVISORY: Deputy Involved In Traffic Collision

A Fresno County Sheriff's Deputy was involved in a two car collision late Sunday night at the intersection of Shaw & Locan.

On August 26th at approximately 9:50 pm, Deputy Chris Tullus of the Boating Enforcement Unit, was driving his Ford Expedition westbound on Shaw Ave. approaching Locan Ave.

At the same time, a 2003 Honda Accord, driven by 27 year old Kao Saechao was also approaching the intersection south bound on Locan. Saechao failed to stop at the posted stop sign and drove directly into the path of Deputy Tullus' vehicle. The patrol vehicle struck Saechao's vehicle in the front driver side area.

As a result, both Deputy Tullus and Saechao were transported to Community Regional Medical Center. Deputy Tullus was treated and released. Saechao was treated for his injuries and was listed in stable condition.

The accident is being investigated by Clovis Police Department's Major Accident Team.
