MEDIA ADVISORY: One Burglar Arrested, Another Sought

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrest of a 26 year old Fresno woman on charges of burglary, vehicle theft, and possession of stolen property. Arrested was Shylo Jalene Badiali.

On March 30th, shortly before 11:30 pm, deputies were dispatched to a silent burglar alarm call at a residence located in the 6400 block of N. Sequoia Ave.

After arriving at the residence, deputies started searching the exterior of the residence. While searching in the back yard, deputies discovered Badiali crouched down near the sliding glass door. She was immediately detained without incident.

Further investigation revealed that a second subjects may have fled prior to the deputies arrival.

Upon checking the residence, deputies determined that Badiali and the other possible suspect had entered the residence by forcing open a rear door, triggering the silent alarm.

Investigators also discovered that Badiali and the other possible suspect had arrived in a stolen vehicle that was parked nearby the residence.

Badiali was later booked into the Fresno County Jail on the charges and the investigation is continuing.
