MEDIA ADVISORY: One Subject Arrested, Another Sought In Burglary

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims today announced the arrest of one subject, and is also asking for the public's help in locating a second, in connection with the burglary of a residence located in the 10000 block of W. Shields Ave. Arrested was 32 year old Jimmy Wayne Cervelli of Fresno. Wanted is his father, 54 year old Keith Lelan Cervelli, also of Fresno.

The incident began yesterday, shortly after 5:00 pm when deputies responded to the residence regarding a burglary call.

The victim reported he had arrived home to find a black colored newer model "Harley Davidson" edition Ford pick up parked at the rear of his residence on his covered patio. Think that the pick up belonged to contractors working on the home, the victim pulled along side the pick up. He attempted to get the identities of the two subjects inside the pick up but they drove away before he could do so. Upon checking his residence, the victim found that approximately \$1200.00 in property had been taken. The victim was able to give deputies a good description of the pick up and both suspects.

A short time later, assisting deputies discovered a pick up that matched the description at a residence located in the 4000 block of N. Floyd Ave. Jimmy Cervelli was standing beside the pick up when deputies arrived. Deputies then discovered some of the stolen property in the bed of the pick up. They also discovered more of the stolen property that had been burned in a burn pile on the property. The investigation revealed that Jimmy and Keith Cervelli were responsible for the burglary.

Jimmy Cervelli was arrested on charges of burglary, possession of stolen property, and a probation violation. He was later booked into the Fresno County Jail.

Keith Cervelli has not been located and is wanted on charges of burglary and possession of stolen property.
