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Detectives Release Descriptions of Possible Murder Suspects

Homicide detectives with the Fresno County Sheriff's Office have gathered information on a July 1st case, which has lead them to develop descriptions of two men as potential murder suspects. They have also learned of a possible suspect car involved in the murder.

Suspect #1: Hispanic man in his early 20s, 5'5", 100 lbs., brown eyes and black hair. He has tattoos on his face and neck.

Suspect #2: Hispanic man in his mid to late 20s, 5'8", 160 lbs., brown eyes and black hair. He has tattoos on his face.

Car: 1999 4-door beige colored Toyota Camry

Both suspects may be armed, so the public should not approach them. Instead, call law enforcement immediately.

Just before 3:00 pm on July 1, 2017, Fresno County Sheriff's deputies responded to the area of N. Cedar Ave. and Arden Drive North in Fresno's Mayfair District for a report of shots fired. There they found a man with bullet wounds. He was later identified as 23 year old Miguel Valenzuela of Fresno. He was taken to the hospital and later died. Detectives believe **Suspect #1** and **Suspect #2** got out of the **Toyota Camry** and fired several rounds at Valenzuela and his friends before fleeing the area.
