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Detectives Uncover 23 lbs. of Meth Hidden in Car

Detectives with the Fresno County Sheriff's Narcotics Enforcement Unit have arrested 27 year old Osmar Jimenez-Pena of Fresno. He has been booked into the Fresno County Jail on felony charges of possessing drugs for sale, transporting drugs for sale and using a false compartment. His bail is set at \$170,000.

Around 7:45 pm on Thursday, Fresno County Sheriff's narcotics detectives made a traffic stop on a 2004 Ford Mustang. This occurred in the area of Manning and McCall Avenues in Selma. Detectives contacted the driver, Osmar Jimenez-Pena. During a search of the car, detectives discovered a hidden compartment and inside they found individual packages of methamphetamine totaling 23 pounds.
