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Deputies Arrest Tollhouse Man for Illegal Possession of Guns and Ammunition

Fresno County Sheriff's deputies have booked 42 year old Bryan Stark and his 39 year old girlfriend Jeana McMahon, both of Tollhouse, into the Fresno County Jail. Stark faces multiple felony charges related to being a felon in possession of guns, ammunition and large capacity magazines. McMahon was later released from jail after receiving a misdemeanor citation for obstructing an officer's investigation.

On March 12th, Fresno County Sheriff's deputies responded to a report of an assault with a deadly weapon. The location was on the 33000 block of Lodge Road in Tollhouse, less than a mile away from Sierra High School.

The man making the report claimed that his friend, Bryan Stark, accused him of stealing, which led to Stark pointing a gun at his head and threatening to kill him. Stark is a regular user of methamphetamine. Deputies contacted Stark and McMahon at their property and spoke with them about the incident. Following the interviews, deputies obtained a search warrant to look inside a barn on the property where the couple was living. Inside they found a total of 24 guns, which included handguns and rifles. Large capacity magazines and ammunition were also discovered. Deputies found several of the guns in a safe hidden in the floor of the barn.
