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Detectives Search for Distinct Vehicle Tied to Car Burglary

Around 5:45 am on Sunday, May 27th, a car was broken into outside the Longhorn Saloon, located at 6943 W. Shields Ave. in Fresno. A Fresno County Sheriff's deputy responded and took a report from the victim who claimed a few personal items had been stolen. The deputy was able to collect surveillance video recorded by nearby cameras. The video shows a possible suspect. It's a man wearing pants and a hooded sweatshirt who was walking through the parking lot. There were also images of a vehicle believed to belong to the suspect. The vehicle appears to be a white Chrysler PT Cruiser with a dark rear passenger door and rear hatch door.
