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Burglars Target Auto Supply Store Multiple Times

Property crimes detectives with the Fresno County Sheriff's Office need the public's help to identify suspects involved in three burglaries and one attempted burglary. They all took place at the same business of Detail Garage Fresno, located at 3131 E. Central Ave. in Fresno. Auto care products such as soaps, waxes and electric polishing machines were stolen during the break-ins. This store primarily specializes in selling the product line called Chemical Guys. Total losses range from thousands to tens of thousands of dollars.

Burglary #1

- December 30, 2019 at 11:27 pm
- Three people wearing hooded sweatshirts
- White single cab Chevy Silverado pickup truck
- Entered by smashing door window with a metal bar

Burglary #2

- January 1, 2021 at 4:48 am
- One man wearing a hooded sweatshirt
- Light-colored four door car with sunroof, possibly a Nissan Altima
- Entered by throwing a rock through a window

Burglary #3

- January 18, 2021 at 3:55 am
- Two men wearing hooded sweatshirts
- Light-colored four door car with sunroof, possibly a Nissan
- Entered by throwing a rock through a window

Attempted burglary

- February 18, 2021 at 2:07 am
- Two men wearing hooded sweatshirts
- Black Chevy Avalanche pickup truck
- Attempted break window with a metal bar

It is unknown if any of the same people were involved in these different burglaries. Detectives ask the public to report suspicious activity such as someone trying to sell them Chemical Guys products or Flex polishing machines either online or in person.
